



CASTILLA Y LEÓN: The Route of Golf Courses

This eight-day intensive itinerary is meant for those golf enthusiasts wanting to spend as much as eight hours a day playing golf, or it can be adapted for others for whom four hours will suffice. It is a flexible itinerary intended to accommodate both.

Day 1: Madrid–Avila

Morning departure from Madrid for Avila. Check in at the Parador of Avila, a former XVI century palace.

Tour of the city and its famous walls.

Lunch at the Parador

Departure for the 18-hole **Golf Club “El Fresnillo”**

Afternoon of golf

Dinner at a restaurant in Avila; optional nightlife

Overnight at the Parador

Day 2: Avila–Salamanca

Morning: Avid golfers can return to the “El Fresnillo” course; others can opt for a more in-depth city tour.

Lunch: a “Tapas” lunch in Avila

Afternoon departure for Salamanca; walking tour of the city’s main square and other attractions.

Dinner at a typical restaurant with music by a group of university serenaders. After dinner drinks near the University.

Overnight at the Hotel AC



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Day 3: Salamanca

Morning golfing at Salamanca's 18-hole Zapaticos Golf Course.

Lunch at the Club

Afternoon free with optional activities: more golf or a cultural city tour of Salamanca's cathedrals, the university and other sites.

A Tapas Dinner at a popular Salamanca restaurant

Overnight at the Hotel AC

Day 4: Simancas (Valladolid)

Morning departure for the Parador in Tordesillas in the province of Valladolid.
Check in at the parador.

Day of golf at the 18-hole Entrepinos Golf Club in Simancas, with a break for lunch at the Club.

Return to the parador

Dinner in the Boecillo Casino in Valladolid???, followed by gaming if desired.

Overnight at the Parador in Tordesillas.

Day 5: Lerma-Burgos

Morning departure for Lerma (Province of Burgos)

Day of golf at the 18-hole course, with lunch at the Club

Late afternoon walking tour of the Baroque town of Lerma

Dinner with a concert at the Hotel Landa Palace



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Day 6: Lerma–Burgos

Free day with options of:

Golf at the Lerma Golf Club (including lunch at the Club) or

Artistic tour of the city's monumental buildings, including lunch and a visit to the Monastery of Santo Domingo de Silos, a Romanesque jewel; a walk along the Yecla Ravine, and attendance at vespers to hear the monks' Gregorian chants.

Return to the parador

Dinner at the Ojeda Restaurant in Burgos

Overnight at the Parador of Lerma.

Day 7: Segovia–Madrid Golf Course

Morning departure for Segovia

Day of golf at a choice of top notch courses around Segovia.

Lunch at the Golf Club

Afternoon option of an artistic tour of Segovia and La Granja

Dinner in Segovia

Overnight at the Parador in Segovia.

Day 8: Depart for Madrid's Barajas Airport; end of tour
